## N. S. W. STATE TITLES

The 1989 N.S.W. Paper Tiger State Titles were run by the Koonawarra Bay Sailing Club on Lake Illawarra over 24/25/26 February. Garry Williams made it his eighth state title, winning three of the four heats sailed.(Heat 4 was cancelled due to strong wind).

In the first heat, the fleet got away in a nice 8-12 knot NorEaster. The fleet split on the first bont with Garry Williams and David Stumbles leading the charge to the right, while Jon Pinkerton, Ewen McArthur and Wayne Eager led another group to the left. Garry and David were the first two around the mark, both showing excellent speed in the conditions to stay in front till the finish. Garry crossed the line 2min 9sec shead of Dave, with another 1min 51sec back to Jon Pinkerton. These three would prove to be the dominant boats of the series, always being the top three.

The smile on Tony Batch's face indicated the the strength of the breeze that afternoon. The NorEastor had piped up to 15-20 knots for heat 2. Jon Pinkerton didn't look too unhappy about the breeze either. His smile was to get a lot bigger, too, as he diced with Garry Williams around the whole course, and managed to break Garry's dominance by taking the race by 24sec to Garry, with David Stumbles another lmin 5ised behind Garry. Wayne Eager was next, just over a minute behind Dave, and was followed up by a grinning Tony Batch, revelling in the conditions, to score his best result (5th).

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The next morning, the boats set off into an unusual Northerly of around 5 knots, with a very shifty first boat. Garry rounded the top mark first and set off, never to be headed. Jon Pinkerton was next and lapped up the breeze as it swung to the NE and picked up to 15 knots. Garry took the race by a convincing 5min 5sec from Jon with another 1min 16sec back to Dave Stumbles, who recovered well after being well down around the first mark. Another 51sec behind was a consistent Ewen McArthur, who managed to hold out Ian Holly by 18sec.

The breeze kicked in even more in the afternoon and was consistently over 25 knots, so the race was cancelled. Garry Williams was a little disappointed, desperately wanting another heavy weather crack at Jon Pinkerton.

Garry was to firmly stamp his dominance on the fleet in the final heat, which was sailed in near Wagga conditions. The very shifty SouBaster blew in at around 5 knots, occasionally rising to 10 and sometimes nearly dying out altogether. After a fairly ordinary first beat, Garry marched away from the fleet, leaving the others to do the dicing. Garry took the race by a demoralising Smin 14sec from Jon Pinkerton, who got away from David Stumbles in the latter stages, after a very close dice for most of the race, to beat him by 50sec, with a highly improved and very fast finishing Reg Pearce in fourth, another 56sec behind.

Congratulations to Garry on his eighth State Title win. An excellent effort.
