NATIONAL TITLES REPORT

National Title Series at Paynesville. Ray had the Title won with a heat to go, and although he didn't win a heat, his superb consistency (check out the enclosed result sheet) made him a worthy Champion. The racing at Paynesville was extremely competitive, and for the first time we Victorians didn't have it all our own way. Second placegetter Gary Williams (Snagglepuss) of NSW, like Ray was very consistent and made few mistakes - with the fleet of 74 having so many boats with good speed, one bad move could cost a lot of places. Gary only joined the Tiger fleet last year, but he was 1978 Australian and NSW Quickcat Champion, which is not a bad sort of apprenticeship. Third place was won by Bob Ramsay (Bobskat) who is a great performer year in, year out. He sailed with the handicap of two large holes in his mast (did the measurer approve ?) courtesy of the SEC (see elsewhere in this issue). Fourth place went to Neil Williams (Indelibly Stamped) who performed the remarkable feat of sailing two 'half-boats' hastily assembled after his starboard hull was demolished in a collision during Heat 3. (the Race Committee gave him average points for this heat). Neil was indebted to Ray Cann for the loan of Artful Dodger II/2. David Hart (Whole Harted) showed his speed as the series progressed, being first across the line in four heats, but a 50% penalty in Heat 3 cost him several places overall. One of the biggest improvers seen in a long time was Geoff Walker (Odd Sox) who confirmed the promise he has shown earlier this year by finishing 8th, two places behind the reliable Brian Robinson. The performances of Ian Marcovitch (Dipped in Blood, NSW), Chris Herdon (Priority One, SA), and Jack Wasley (Betty Brown, SA) will give a good boost to the PT fleets in NSW and SA, as well as giving the Victorian fleet a good stir. (To realise just what the 'Top Ten' skippers achieved, take a look down the list at the standard of the next few skippers). Regarding the conditions under which the series was sailed, the winds were pretty fair, with only Heat 5 having to be resailed due to winds of 30

pretty fair, with only Heat 5 having to be resailed due to winds of 30 knots and over. Heats 1, 2 and 6 had somewhat flukey breezes of less than 10 knots, which combined with the weed in the lake to cause some inconvenience. However the remaining heats were sailed in good condition with winds between 12 - 25 knots.
